		<p>requirement would be 5 for the promotion. <b>(Annexure-12 A)</b></p> <p>In the 6<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting, under the agenda no. 1, the minimum CGPA requirement of 5.0 was relaxed till the end of B.Tech. 5<sup>th</sup> semester for the students who have taken admission in the Academic year 2018-19. <b>(Annexure-12 B)</b></p> <p>Since March 2020, due to COVID-19 pandemic (1<sup>st</sup> &amp; 2<sup>nd</sup> wave), neither offline nor online examination could be taken. To safeguard the future of the students, it is proposed that the students who have failed in the current academic year may be promoted provisionally to the next semester/ year. However, such students will have to clear the examination for the course in which he/ she has failed/ remained absent, whenever the examination is held next time. This relaxation is not applicable for the final semester students of Diploma, Under Graduate and Post Graduate of any discipline.</p>

18.	Commencement of 5 <sup>th</sup> Semester Online Classes for the students having CGPA of less than 4.5.	The 5th semester class for the students were not allowed earlier to attend with regular students because of 4.5 CGPA criteria. As per the notification issued on 11-05-2021 it has been decided to resume the online classes for such students by the Institutes/Colleges. These students will also attend the regular online classes for 6th semester as per JUT notification. The students having less than 4.5 CGPA will appear for Online examination for 5th semester when it will be notified by the University. The matter needs to be discussed to facilitate their post facto approval. <b>(Annexure-15)</b>	After perusal and discussion at length by members present, it was applauded and unanimously approved.
19.	Registration on NPTEL & Adoption of MOOC's.	UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM) Regulation, 2016 was published on 19th July, 2016 in The Gazette of India. It was suggested to consider online learning courses being offered through the SWAYAM platform. Matter related to registration on National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) Portal & Adoption of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC). It has provided comparison of its 4 Year Diploma in Tool & Die Making (DTDM) with Diploma in Mechanical Engineering given by State Board of Technical Education, Ranchi which is already merged in Jharkhand University of Technology, Ranchi. <b>(Annexure-17)</b> It is proposed that an expert committee may be formed to evaluate this proposal of IDTR and give report to the Chairman of Academic Council.
